If a dog is entered in both Obedience or Rally Trials on the same day, you **MUST** pay the fee for the **FIRST ENTRY** of the dog in each trial each day as they are separate AKC events. For example a dog entered in Trial 1 Novice B (\$29.00) Trial 2 Novice B (\$29.00) for a total of \$ 58.00.

Entries will be limited to 48 exhibitors total. Multiple class entries are encouraged. We have mapped out 48 crating spaces that are 6 feet x 6 feet (each competitor gets 36 sq. feet of crating space.) It will allow two full size large crates per space plus a chair and follows the CDC guidelines for 6 foot distancing.

A paper or cloth mask must be worn inside the building at ALL times. Inside the showing the exhibitor may choose to use a full face clear shield (must wrap the face and come below the chin) in place of the mask. Once outside the ring the mask must be worn again.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

CLOSING DATE for entries is 8:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 2, 2020 after which time entries cannot be accepted, changed or cancelled except as allowed per move up clause below. Entries must be signed by owner or agent and submitted with fees. No telephone or fax entries can be accepted. **EXPRESS DELIVERY services must include SIGNATURE WAIVER permitting them to be left WITHOUT recipient's signature.**

ENTRIES ARE LIMITED to eight hours of judging time per day, per judge and/or a total of 46 exhibitors will be taken on a first come, first serve basis (so get your entries in early). Regular Class entries, including the UDX class, will be given first priority followed by the Optional Titling Classes followed by the Non-Regular Classes.

Included in the entry fees: A \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog will be collected by the American Kennel Club for all Regular AKC classes (fees do not apply to Non-Regular Classes). A Recording Fee of \$0.50 will also be collected for each entry of a dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Obedience.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, unsafe weather conditions or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Transfers (formerly Move-ups)

- After a dog earns a title, a transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made.
- The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

For a written request regarding a transfer for an ineligible dog and handler team from the "A" class to the "B" class at the same level, please refer to the AKC Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16b

VACCINATIONS ETC. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

BITCHES that come into season after the closing date for entries may have the entry fee less \$4.00 per dog per class refunded upon written request of the owner or handler before the start of judging on the day of the trial.

ATTENTION ALL EXHIBITORS

* Misconduct at hotels/motels may result in an Event Committee hearing. * Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their dogs at the ODTCTraining Building and at hotels/motels. 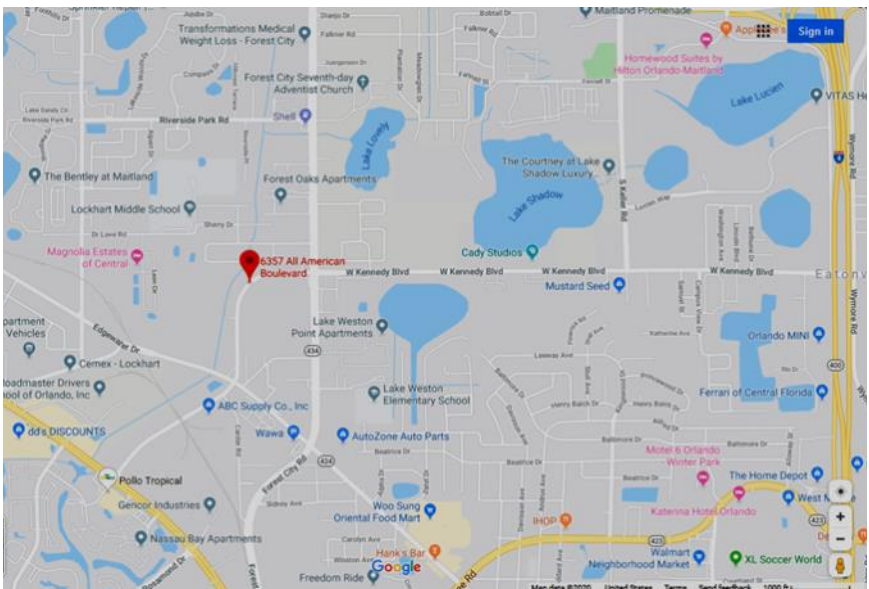
From the South on I-4: Heading East (North) on I4, Exit at Lee Road and head West (left) turn Right on Edgewater Drive, Right at the light onto All American Blvd. Building will be on the right on the curve.

From North of Orlando on I-4: Heading West (south) on I4 Exit at Lee Road and head West (right) turn Right on Edgewater Drive, Right at the light onto All American Blvd. Building will be on the right on the curve.

From South Orlando using 441/Orange Blossom Trail: Head north, cross over Lee Road, turn Right on All American Blvd., cross over Edgewater Drive at the light and building will be on the right.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
